## Job Description

### **Electrician**

#### NATURE OF WORK

The primary job duty for this position will be the instrumentation technician for the surface water plant.

Assists and performs semi-skilled construction and installation of electrical services to City facilities also and other work as directed.

Performs specialized electrical work associated with a variety of electronic and instrumentation equipment.

Work is performed under the general supervision of the Surface Water Treatment Plant Manager.

Works inside and outside in various weather conditions with slippery surfaces and around dangerous chemicals and heights.

This is a highly technical position that requires troubleshooting of instrumentation in an industrial environment.

#### EXAMPLES OF WORK

Assists in the construction of electrical/instrumentation services to City facilities.

Assists and troubleshoots electrical/instrumentation problems in various facilities.

Performs routine preventative maintenance of electrical/instrumentation services to insure proper operation.

Performs routine preventative maintenance of mechanical services to insure proper operation.

Performs related work as required.
