The City of Port St. Joe will be putting in an 9 hole disc golf course at Dooder Park. It will be a free course for disc golfers of all ages to enjoy. The course will be open from 8:00 AM EST – Sunset everyday. The course will start in Dooder Park by the parking area and will work its way around Buck Griffin Lake. What is Disc Golf:

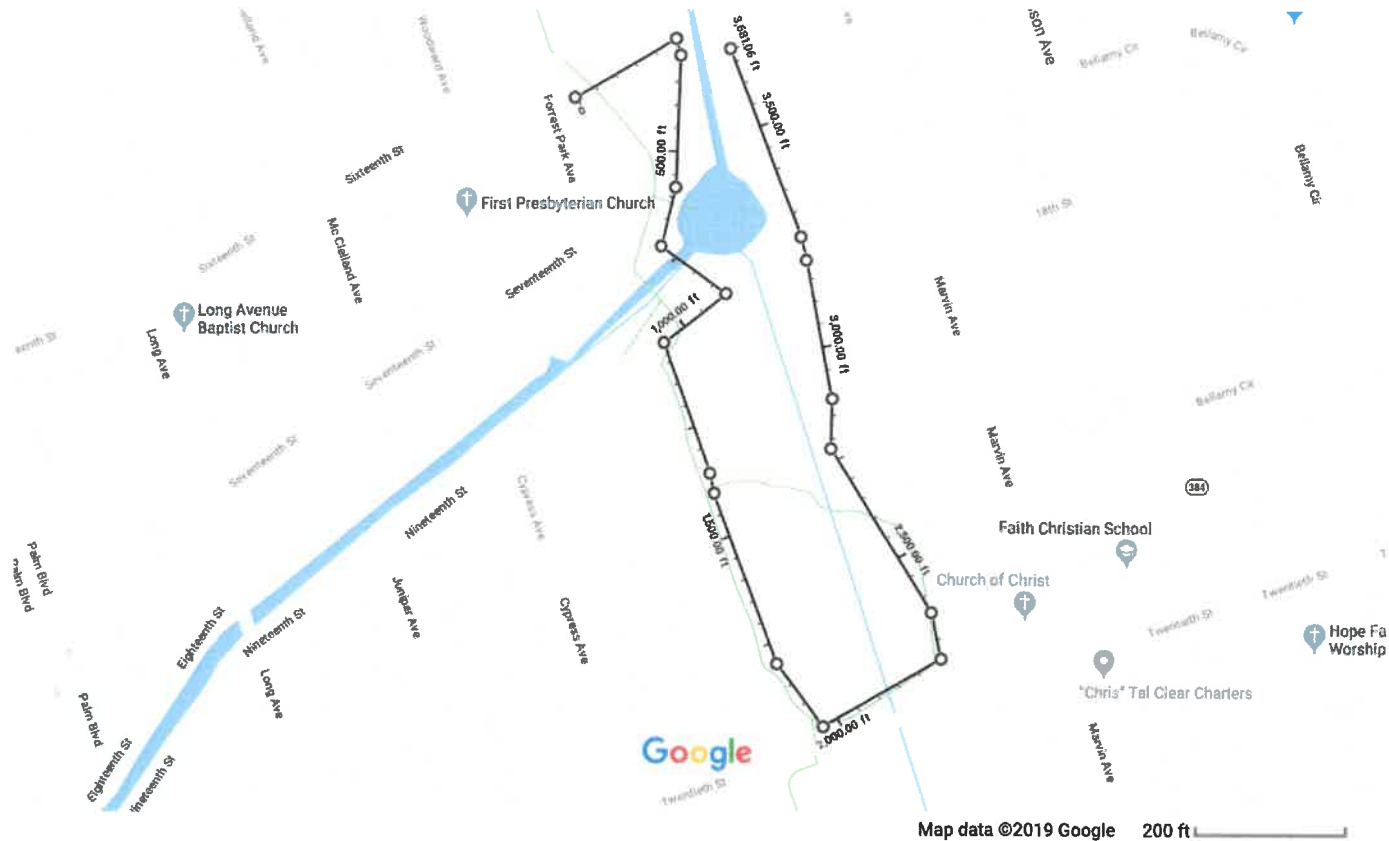
The sport of disc golf is played much like traditional golf. Instead of using balls and clubs, players use discs and metal baskets. A golf disc is thrown from a tee pad to a metal basket which is the hole. As the player progresses through the course, he or she must throw from where their previous shot landed. The trees, shrubs and elevations changes located throughout the course provide challenging obstacles for the player. The hole is completed when the disc lands in the basket.

Benefits of Disc Golf:

Disc golf is a sport for any age or gender to participate in and provides a safe means of exercise for all age groups. Disc golf highlights existing natural features throughout the park with little to no impact to the environment or homeowners. It is a great way for family and friends to enjoy time together.
