

ORDINANCE NO. 110

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND COMPENSATION OF THE OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, FLORIDA, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Commission that the fixing of salaries and compensation for the City Officials and Employees of the City of Port St. Joe is necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the peace, safety, health and property of the City and its inhabitants, and to provide for the usual daily operation of the Municipality and its Departments, and in compliance with Section 66 of the City Code and Charter, now, therefore,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE:

Section I. That the salaries of the City Officials and Employees of the City of Port St. Joe for Fiscal Year 1979/80 shall be as follows:
