

ORDINANCE NO. 118

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE TENTATIVE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1980-81 FOR THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, FLORIDA, BY RE-ADOPTING THE APPROPRIATIONS FOR 1979-1980, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FOR THE ORDINARY AND REGULAR REQUIREMENTS OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1980-1981, DECLARING THE PASSAGE OF SAID ORDINANCE TO BE AN EMERGENCY, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission is of the opinion that it is necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of peace, safety, health, and property of the City and its inhabitants, and to provide for the usual daily operation of the City and its departments that this Ordinance be enacted and take effect immediately, therefore

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE:

Section I. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$795,259.00 for the General Fund, the sum of \$2,174,810.00 for the Water and Sewer Fund, the sum of \$17,870.00 for the Oak Grove Water and Sewer Fund, and the \$2,695,350.00 for the Wastewater Treatment Plant for Fiscal Year 1980-1981 to be used in the operation of said departments for the City of Port St. Joe, Florida, as set forth in the Budget and Financial Plan of said City on file with the City Auditor and Clerk.

Section II. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish a notice of this ordinance as provided by law.

Section III. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
