ORDINANCE NO. 135

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE LEVY OF TAXES IN THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, FLORIDA, FOR THE TAX YEAR 1982, LEVY-ING AN AD VALOREM TAX OF 3.846 MILLS ON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN SAID CITY, WHICH IS NOT EXEMPT UNDER THE LAW, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE ORDINARY AND REGULAR REQUIREMENTS OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE FOR FISCAL YEAR 1982/1983; PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The City Commission is of the opinion that it is necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the peace, safety, health and property of the City and its inhabitants, and to provide for the usual daily operation of the City and its departemnts, that this Ordinance be enacted. THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE:

SECTION I. That there be, and there is hereby, levied and assessed upon all property, both Real and Personal, within the Corporate Limits of the City of Port St. Joe, not exempt form taxation by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, the following Ad Valorem Tax for the year 1982:

A. A Tax of 3.846 mills upon the dollar of assessed valuation for the purposes of providing for funds for the ordinary and regular purpose of the City of Port St. Joe, Florida, for the Fiscal Year 1982/1983 said valuation to be used upon the Assessment Roll of said City as previously approved and adopted.

SECTION II. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
