

ORDINANCE NO. 27

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE USE OF STREETS AND THOROUGHFARES IN THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, FLORIDA, PROVIDING THAT SWINGING ACCESS DOORS OF VEHICLES MUST BE CLOSED AND SECURED DURING OPERATION, AND PRESCRIBING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS HEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE:

SECTION 1. No person shall drive or operate or knowingly permit to be driven or operated, on any street or thoroughfare of this municipality any vehicle or vehicles, unless all side and rear swinging access doors, if any, have been closed and secured against swinging open during operation.

SECTION 2. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), or imprisonment in the City Jail not exceeding thirty (30) days, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Municipal Judge.
