

**ORDINANCE NO. 277**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE TERMINATING THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE POLICE OFFICERS' PENSION TRUST FUND, AS ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 230, AND AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 269, PROVIDING FOR PARTICIATION IN THE FLORIDA RETIREMENT SYSTEM AS PROVIDED FOR IN ORDINANCE NO. 74; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS,** The City of Port St. Joe Police Officers are presently provided pension and certain other benefits under Ordinances No. 230 and 267 and;

**WHEREAS,** the City Commission of the City of Port St. Joe desires to provide equal benefits for all employees and desires that all employees be covered by the Florida Retirement System as provided for in Ordinance No. 74;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1:** That the Port St. Joe Police Officers' Pension Trust Fund, adopted by Ordinance No. 230 and amended by Ordinance No. 269, is hereby terminated and all current employees are providing membership in the Florida Retirement System as provided in Ordinance No. 74.

**SECTION 2.** Specific authority is hereby granted to codify and incorporate this ordinance in the existing code of ordinance of the City of Port St. Joe.

**SECTION 3.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4.** If any section, subsection, sentence clause or phrase of this ordinance, or any particular application thereof shall be held invalid by any court, administrative agency, or other body with appropriate jurisdiction, the remaining section, subsection, sentences, clauses, or phrases under application shall not be affected thereby.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall be effective July 1, 2001.
