

ORDINANCE NO. 401

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE #389 (WATER) BY AMENDING SECTION 1. DEFINITION; AMENDING SECTION 2. BASE RATE, PROVIDE FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, FLORIDA, as follows:

1. Ordinance #389, Section 1b and c and Section 2 b and c currently provides as follows:

(1). b. Commercial 1 is defined as any business or commercial establishment whose water usage does not exceed 1.25 ERC which equals 375 gallons per day average .

c. Commercial II is defined as any business or commercial establishment whose water usage exceeds 1.25 ERC which is equals 376 gallons per day average.

2. Ordinance #389, Section 1b and c and Section 2b and c, is amended to read as follows:

(1) b. Commercial 1 is defined as any business or commercial establishment whose water usage does not exceed 1.50 ERC which equals 450 gallons per day and up to 13,500.00 gallons for 30 days

c. Commercial II is defined as any business or commercial establishment whose water usage exceeds 1.50 ERC which is greater than 450 gallons per day average.
