PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE PWS # 1230545

TO: Customers at: 432 Howard Road

Due to an accidental break to the water main or a need to repair a water line that supplies your drinking water, there is a concern for possible contamination. Therefore, as a precaution, we advise that all water used for <u>drinking or cooking</u> be boiled. A rolling boil of one minute is sufficient. As an alternative bottled water may be used for these purposes.

When the main has been repaired and flushed, bacteriological samples of the water will be collected and sent to the laboratory. This *precautionary boil water notice* will remain in effect until the bacteriological samples shows the water is safe to drink.
