AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5 OF ARTICLE 3 OF THE PLUMBING CODE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE BY ADDING THERETO SECTION 5-111; PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF SCHEDULE 40 PVC PIPE IN CERTAIN INSTANCES; REQUIRING CLEAN-OUT PLUGS IN LINES CONNECTING WITH THE CITY SEWER; REQUIRING PERMIT FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF PIPE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTIAL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5-111 is hereby created to read:

- "A. It shall be permissible to use Schedule 40 PVC pipe for building sewer lines provided that the pipe shall be used only from and beyond a distance of 5 feet from a building to the point of connection with the City Sewer System.
- B. Any person or firm connecting to the City Sewer System of the City of Port St. Joe, Florida, shall provide a clean-out plug at the point where the individual line connects to the City Sewer.
- C. A standard Plumbing Permit shall be required at any time that a property owner desires to replace in excess of 5 feet of any existing fine running from a building structure to the City Sewer System."
- Section 2. All ordinances or partial ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
- Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days from final adoption.
