

ORDINANCE NO. 11

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE; ADOPTING THE FLORIDA MODEL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR MUNICIPALITIES AND PROVIDING FOR THE ENFORCEMENT THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City Commission is of the opinion that it is necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the peace, safety, health and property of the City and its inhabitants, and to provide for the usual daily operation of the City and its departments that this ordinance be enacted and take effect immediately; therefore,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. There is hereby adopted for the purpose of regulating traffic in the City of Port St. Joe, Florida, that certain traffic ordinance known as the Florida Model Traffic Ordinance, being Chapter 57-333, Laws of Florida, and the whole thereof, save and except such portions as may hereinafter be deleted, motified or amended.

Section 2. That whenever the term "Traffic Engineer" is used in said ordinance, it shall also mean the Chief of Police of said City.
