

ORDINANCE NO. 15

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ASSESSMENT AND LEVY OF TAXES IN THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, FLORIDA, FOR THE TAX YEAR A. D. 1964; LEVYING AN ADVALOREM TAX OF 12.2 MILLS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE ORDINARY AND REGULAR PURPOSES OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1964-1965.

WHEREAS, the City Commission is of the opinion that it is necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the peace, safety, health, and property of the City and its inhabitants, and to provide for the usual daily operation of the City and its departments that this Ordinance be enacted and take effect immediately, therefore,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE;

Section 1. That the assessment roll of the taxable property within the City of Port St. Joe for the year 1964, prepared by the City Auditor and Clerk, as ex-officio Tax Assessor and approved by the City Tax Equalizing Board be, and the same is hereby approved and adopted as the assessment roll of Taxable property within the City of Port St. Joe, for the Tax Year 1964.

Section 2. That there be and there is hereby levied and assessed upon all property, both real and personal, within the corporate limits of the City of Port St. Joe, not exempt from taxation by the Constitution and Laws of the State of Florida, the following ad valorem taxes for the year 1964.

(a) A tax of 12.2 mills upon the dollar of assessed valuation for the purpose of providing funds for the ordinary and regular purposes of the City of Port St. Joe.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

INTRODUCED at a regular meeting of the City Commission on the 15th day of September A. D. 1964 and ADOPTED by the City Commission on the 15th day of September A. D. 1964 as an Emergency Ordinance.
