

ORDINANCE NO. 18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION (5) OF SECTION 10 OF ORDINANCE NO. 3 ENTITLED:

"AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR THE OWNER OR OCCUPANT OF ANY PREMISES TO ALLOW GARBAGE, YARD TRASH, FILTH, OR OTHER TYPES OF REFUSE TO ACCUMULATE ON HIS PREMISES; PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF PORT ST. JOE; PROHIBITING REMOVAL BY PERSONS OTHER THAN EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY, OR PERSONS OR FIRMS PROPERLY AUTHORIZED BY THE CITY COMMISSION; REQUIRING GARBAGE CANS; PROVIDING FOR FEES FOR COLLECTION; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND REPEALING ANY ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF PORT ST. JOE:

SECTION 1. That Subsection (5) of Section 10 of Ordinance No. 3 be, and it is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph to Subsection (5) at the end thereof, to-wit:

"Supermarkets shall maintain and provide in a convenient location easily accessible to the garbage collector of the City covered bins or containers of a capacity of at least two cubic yards but not to exceed three cubic yards, according to specifications of the City of Port St. Joe. The City is authorized, however, to purchase and provide such bins or containers and may enter into agreements with the owners or lessees of supermarkets or other wholesale users as to the proper charges to be paid by such persons, firms or corporations for the use of such bins or containers, provided that such agreements shall provide for uniform charges for collection and disposal of garbage per cubic yard. This charge is in addition to the monthly collection charge provided in the immediately preceding paragraph."

Introduced at a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Port St. Joe held on the 19th day of January, 1965, and Adopted at a regular meeting held on the 2nd day of February, 1965.
