ORDINANCE NO. 246



AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TIME AND PLACE OF CITY COMMISSION MEETINGS FOR THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, FLORIDA,

SECTION 2-56 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 1. Organizational meeting. At 8:00 p.m., according to such standard time as shall be used in the city, on the first Tuesday in June, following the municipal election, provided for under the Charter, the city commission shall meet at the usual place for holding meetings of the legislative body of the city, at which time the newly elected commissioners, and mayor, if same shall be elected at such election, shall assume the duties of office.
- 2. Regular meetings. The City Commission of the City of Port St. Joe shall hold its meetings on the first and third Tuesday of each month at 6:00 P.M. The time and date of the meeting may be changed from time to time by resolution or motion of the City Commission, after announcing such change at a duly constituted public hearing or after advertisement for one publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
- 3. Cancellation of meetings. When there is a conflict between the regular meetings and holidays or other special events, the City Commission may cancel or reschedule such meetings by motion or resolution.
 - 4. Place of meetings. All regular and special meetings

shall be held at the Municipal Building in the usual city commission meeting room, unless by motion or resolution the city commission determines another location is more appropriate.

REPEAL: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance is held invalid, the remainder shall not be affected by such invalidity.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.
