ORDINANCE NO. 28

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 1967-68 FOR THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, FLORIDA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE ORDINARY AND REGULAR REQUIREMENTS OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE FOR FISCAL YEAR 1967-68, DECLARING THE PASSAGE OF SAID ORDINANCE TO BE AN EMERGENCY, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission is of the opinion that it is necessary for the immediate portection and preservation of the peace, safety, health, and property of the City and its departments that this Ordinance be enacted and take effect immediately, therefore

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE:

Section I. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$226,196.00 for the Water and Sewer fund for Fiscal Year 1967-68 to be used in the operation of said departments for the City of Port St. Joe, Florida, as set forth in the Budget and Financial Plan of said City on file with the City Auditor and Clerk.

Section II. The City Auditor and Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish a notice of this Ordinance as provided by law.

Section III. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

INTRODUCED at a regular meeting of the City Commission on the $\underline{1st}$ day of August, A.D. 1967, and ADOPTED by the City Commission on the $\underline{15th}$ day of August, A.D. 1967, as an emergency ordinance.
