ORDINANCE NO. 328

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, FLORIDA AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 295 ADOPTED OCTOBER 15, 2002, PROVIDING FOR A NEW SCHEDULE OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS, DELETING PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED SCHEDULE OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
