AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE AMENDING SECTION 6-3, CODE OF ORDINANCES FORBIDDING THE OPERATION OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE ESTABLISHMENT WITHIN 100' OF A CHURCH IN COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL ZONING DISTRICTS, ALLOWING FOR EXCEPTION BY THE CITY COMMISSION, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the City of Port St. Joe, Florida:

1. Section 6-3 of Code of Ordinances of the City of Port St. Joe currently reads as follows:

Section 6-3. Proximity to church or school.

It shall be unlawful to operate an alcoholic beverage establishment licensed by the state within 500 feet of any church or any school within the city.

2. Section 6-3 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Port St. Joe is amended to read as follows:

Section 6-3. Proximity to church or school.

- (a) It shall be unlawful to operate an alcoholic beverage establishment licensed by the state within 500 feet of any church or any school within the city except the 500 foot distance exclusion zone from a church is reduced to a 100 foot distance exclusion zone from a church in a commercial or industrial zone.
- (b) Upon petition to the City Commission and after public notice is given, the City Commission, by a majority vote, may exempt a properly licensed alcoholic beverage establishment located in a commercial or industrial zone from the prohibition in Section 6-3(a) provided no objection is received from the governing body of any church located within the 100 foot distance exclusion zone of the alcoholic beverage establishment
 - 3. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall be effectively immediately upon passage.
