ORDINANCE NO. 384

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, AMENDING SECTION 54-8(b)(2), ORDINANCE #347 OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, CLARIFYING THE PLACEMENT FOR COLLECTION OF YARD RUBBISH, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, FLORIDA:

1. Section 54-8 (b)(2) of Ordinance #347 currently reads as follows:

Yard rubbish shall be placed for collection immediately adjacent to the premises producing such wastes, but not upon the paved street, sidewalk, storm gutter or canal bank. The city will not be responsible for damage to sprinkler systems, sprinkler heads, water meters and other objects, including fences, gates and hedges, other plants and trees damaged due to yard trash being placed over or piled on or against such items as a result of being placed there for collection by the occupants and/or owner of the property.

2. Section 54-8(b)(2) is amended to read:

Yard rubbish shall be placed for collection on the City right of way, said City right of way identified as that portion of the right of way immediately adjacent to the property that produced the yard rubbish (producing property) and further defined as that portion of City right of way located between the extension of property lines of the producing property to the center of the adjacent roadway or alleyway. In no event shall yard rubbish from a producing parcel be placed on the City right of way in the front, or back, of an adjacent parcel. Additionally, no yard waste shall be placed upon a paved street, sidewalk, storm gutter, or canal bank. The city will not be responsible for damage to sprinkler systems, sprinkler heads, water meters and other objects, including fences, gates and hedges, other plants and trees damaged due to yard trash being placed over or piled on or against such items as a result of being placed there for collection by the occupants and/or owner of the property.

- REPEAL: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
- 3. **EFFECTIVE DATE**: This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption as provided by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 384

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, AMENDING SECTION 54-8(b)(2), OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, CLARIFYING THE PLACEMENT FOR COLLECTION OF YARD RUBBISH, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Now, therefore, BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST.

JOE, FLORIDA:

1. Section 54-8 (b)(2) of The Code of Ordinances, City of Port St. Joe currently reads as follows:

Yard rubbish shall be placed for collection immediately adjacent to the premises producing such wastes, but not upon the paved street, sidewalk, storm gutter or canal bank. The city will not be responsible for damage to sprinkler systems, sprinkler heads, water meters and other objects, including fences, gates and hedges, other plants and trees damaged due to yard trash being placed over or piled on or against such items as a result of being placed there for collection by the occupants and/or owner of the property.

2. Section 54-8(b)(2) is amended to read:

Yard rubbish shall be placed for collection on the City right of way, said City right of way identified as that portion of the right of way immediately adjacent to the property that produced the yard rubbish (producing property) and further defined as that portion of City right of way located between the extension of property lines of the producing property to the center of the adjacent roadway or alleyway. In no event shall yard rubbish from a producing parcel be placed on the City right of way in the front, or back, of an adjacent parcel. Additionally, no yard waste shall be placed upon a paved street, sidewalk, storm gutter, or canal bank. The city will not be responsible for damage to sprinkler systems, sprinkler heads, water meters and other objects, including fences, gates and hedges, other plants and trees damaged due to yard trash being placed over or piled on or against such items as a result of being placed there for collection by the occupants and/or owner of the property.

- 2. **REPEAL**: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
- 3. **EFFECTIVE DATE**: This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption as provided by law.
