

ORDINANCE NO.: 412

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE AMENDING SECTION 6-1, CODE OF ORDINANCES, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the People of Port St. Joe, Florida:

1. Section 6-1 of Code of Ordinances of the City of Port St. Joe currently reads as follows:

Section 6-1. Hours of sale.

(a) No alcoholic or intoxicating beverages may be sold, consumed or served, or permitted to be served or consumed in any place holding a license under the state department of business and professional regulation, division of alcoholic beverages and tobacco, between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. of the same day, except upon Sunday when no alcoholic or intoxicating beverages may be sold, consumed or served, or permitted to be served or consumed, between 12:00 midnight on Saturday and 7:00 a.m. on Monday.

2. Section 6-1 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Port St. Joe is amended to read as follows:

Section 6-1. Hours of sale.

(a) No alcoholic or intoxicating beverages may be sold, consumed or served, or permitted to be served or consumed in any place holding a license under the state department of business and professional regulation, division of alcoholic beverages and tobacco, between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. of the same day.

3. **SEVERABILITY:** If any portion of this Ordinance is declared by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable such declaration shall not be deemed to affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

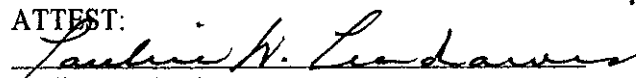
4. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Ordinance shall be effective as provided by law.
