

ORDINANCE NO. 75

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 21 WHICH ORDINANCE HAS TO DO WITH THE LEVYING OF A TAX ON INSURORS FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING CERTAIN POLICE OFFICERS RETIREMENT FUND; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, more suitable arrangements have been made for the proper retirement benefits for the police officers of the City of Port St. Joe than could be previously provided under the levy of Ordinance No. 21, and

WHEREAS, all the laws required to comply with the establishment of police officers retirement benefits within the said retirement fund have been complied with,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted by the people of the City of Port St. Joe, Florida, that Ordinance No. 21 be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.

PASSED and ADOPTED as an Emergency Ordinance, at a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Port St. Joe, Florida, on the 17th day of June, 1975.
