AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES BY THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE: PROVIDING THAT WHERE AVAILABLE LABOR FORCES ARE AVAILABLE WITHIN THE CITY THAT ALL NEW EMPLOYEES BE RESIDENTS OF THE CITY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, from time to time emergencies arise which require employees to be called to work for extra time and after hours. and

WHEREAS, it is not feasible for said employees to be contacted and utilized in case of emergency situations if the employees are living great distances from the city.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. All personnel hereafter hired by the City of Port St. Joe, in any of its departments shall be residents of the City of Port St. Joe, Florida. Provided however, where a particular shift is required for some job and a qualified person or persons cannot be found within the city, the City Commission may employ people residing beyond the City limits upon such terms and conditions as are just. A record of such exceptions shall be duly noted in the minutes of the meeting at which such action is taken.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
