ORDINANCE NO. 90

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND COMPENSATION OF THE OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JUE, FLORIDA, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
