

ORDINANCE NO. 86

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND COMPENSATION OF THE OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE, FLORIDA, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Commission that the fixing of salaries and compensation for the City Officials and Employees of the City of Port St. Joe is necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the peace, safety, health and property of the City and its inhabitants, and to provide for the usual daily operation of the Municipality and its Departments, and in compliance with Section 66 of the City Code and Charter, now, therefore,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE:

Section I. That the salaries of the City Officials and Employees of the City of Port St. Joe for Fiscal Year 1976/77 shall be as follows:

Ordinance No. 86

Section II. The salaries and compensation set forth in Section I hereof shall be payable weekly, except Retired Personnel, Commissioners, Municipal Judge shall be paid monthly.

Section III. All Ordinances or part of Ordianances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section IV. The peace, safety, health and prosperity of the City of Port St. Joe and its inhabitants demand that this Ordinance go into effect and be paid on the third weekly pay-day in June, 1977, with pay retro-active to the first weekly pay-day in October, 1976.

INTRODUCED in the City Commission special meeting on the 14th day of June, 1977, and ADOPTED and PASSED by said Commission on the 14th day of June, 1977, as an emergency ordinance.
