

MINUTES OF THE NRDA GRANT WORKSHOP FOR THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS FOR THE CITY OF PORT ST. JOE FLORIDA, HELD IN THE COMMISSION CHAMBERS, 2775 GARRISON AVENUE, December 3, 2019, AT 5 P.M.

The following were present: Mayor Buzzett, Commissioners Ashbrook, Hoffman, and Lowry. City Manager Jim Anderson, City Clerk Charlotte Pierce, and Public Works Director were also present. Commissioner Langston was absent.

The purpose of the Workshop was a Public Hearing for the kickoff meeting for the Stormwater Improvements Grant Agreement No 19-047.

Mayor Buzzett noted the grant is for \$775,000, was executed on October 11, 2019, for a 52 months period, and he reviewed the Project Timeline and Goals and Objectives of the Grant. He stressed the Workshop was for the purpose of asking questions, offering suggestions, and seeing what the community wanted to do.

A rendering of the project area was on display.

Carlos Herd, and Karen Kebart, Northwest Florida Water Management District, congratulated the City on receiving the grant and noted the purpose of the grant was to increase the quality of the water going into St. Joseph Bay.
